Marijuana	19%

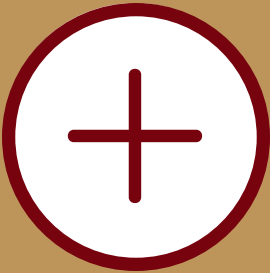
59 accept EBT & **23** accept WIC

Retailers Key Findings



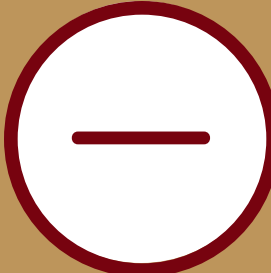
37% displayed graphic health warning signs
