

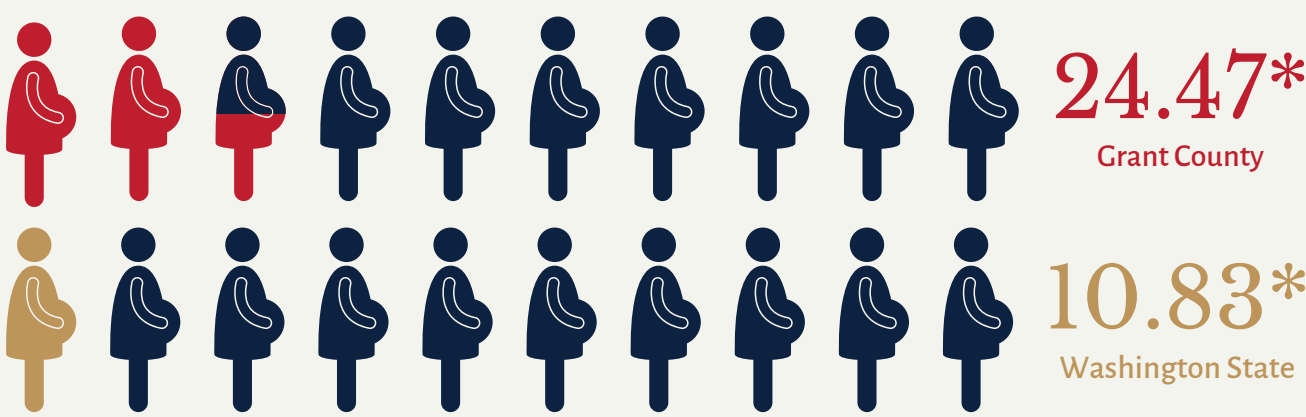

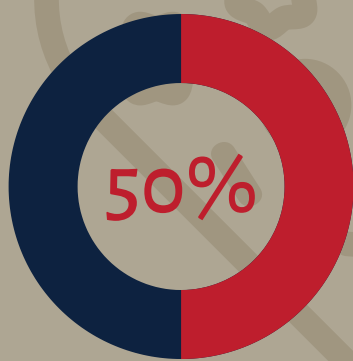


Grant County has a **higher teen birth rate** compared to Washington State.

*Teen birth is calculated as the number of births per 1,000 females aged 15-19.

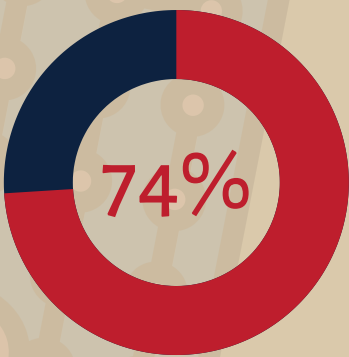

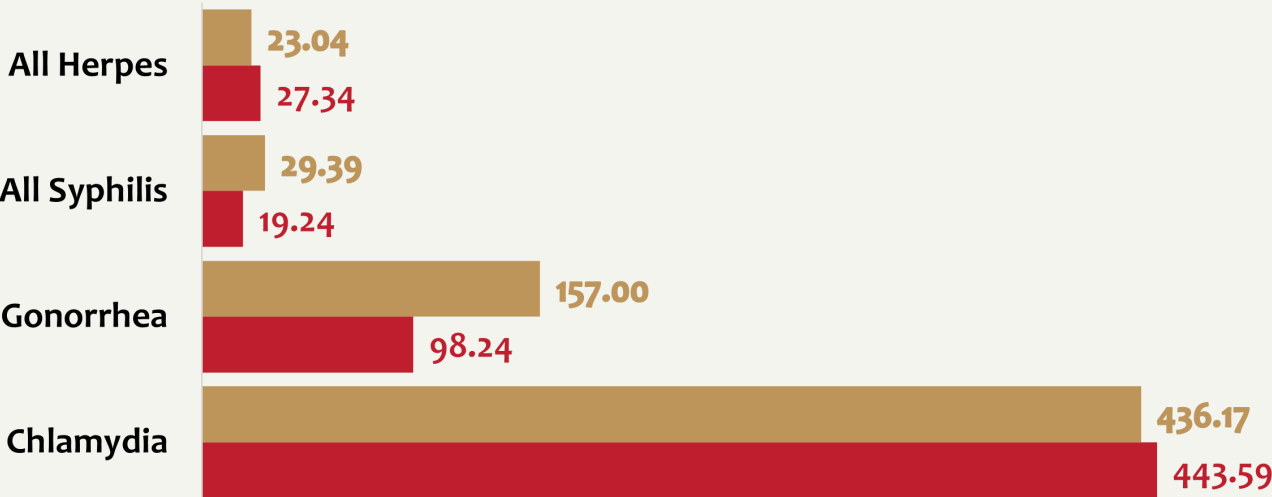
Only **50%** of Grant County **10th graders** who were sexually active **had used a condom to prevent Sexually Transmitted Infections.**

74% of Grant County **10th graders** who were sexually active **had used one or more methods to prevent pregnancy.**

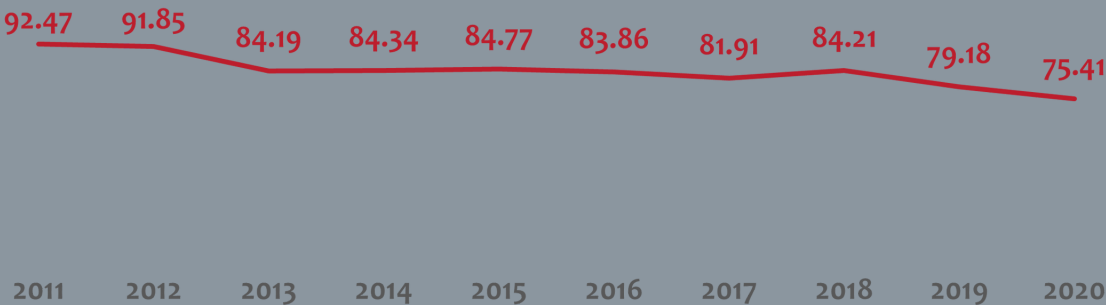
